Inspired by his life-long

interest in music and dance the artist featured 30 new works of Chinese ink, collage and acrylics.

La Tropicana's Peter Payne said there was considerable interest: "People came through every day to stop and have a look, and on the opening night there was about 100

people and quite a lot of his work was sold then," he said.
